

Inflation in Consumer Price Index Up To Third Quarter 2017 - Emirate of Dubai

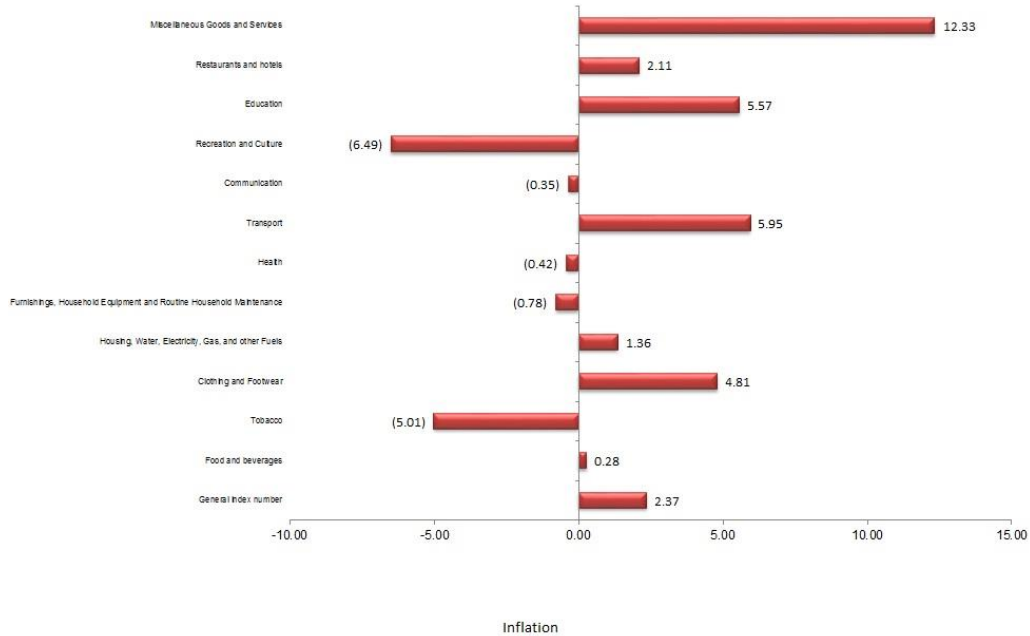
Inflation Rate in the Emirate of Dubai record 2.37% Up To Third Quarter of 2017 compared to the same period of 2016. This is due to an increase in the prices of Miscellaneous Goods and Services group by 12.33%. Transport group increased by 5.95%. Education group by 5.57%. Clothing and Footwear group increased by 4.81%. Restaurants and Hotels group by 2.11%. Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and other Fuels group increased by 1.36%. Food and Beverages group by 0.28%. On the other hand, prices of Recreation and Culture group decreased by 6.49%. Tobacco group decreased to 5.01%. Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance group decreased by 0.78%, Health group decreased by 0.42% and Communication group record a decrease by 0.35%. As shown in table (1) and Figure (1).

Inflation rate in major expenditure groups:

Food and Beverages

Prices of Food and Beverages Group increased by 0.28%. Because of an increase in the prices of Vegetables by 7.56%, Followed by an increase in the prices of Sugar, Jam, Honey, Chocolate, and Confectionery by 0.76% and prices of other food products increased by 0.29%.

Tobacco

Inflation rate of Tobacco group decreased by 5.01%, due to a decrease in the prices of Tobacco by 9.41%.

Clothing and Footwear

The prices of Clothing and Footwear group increased by 4.81%, due to an increase in the prices of Clothing Materials by 10.30%, in addition, the prices of Garments increased by 7.22% and the prices of Other Articles of Clothing and Clothing Accessories increased by 0.15%.

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and other Fuels

Inflation rate of Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and other Fuel group increased by 1.36%. As a result in the increase of the prices of Gas by 10.61%, prices of Liquid Fuels increased by 3.89% and prices of Solid Fuels increased by 1.56%.

Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance

Inflation rate of Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance group decreased to record 0.78%. This due to a decrease in the prices of Household Textiles by 9.85%. Followed by a decrease in the prices of Furniture and Furnishings by 6.67%. Furthermore, the prices of Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils decreased by 4.14%.

Health

Inflation rate of Health group decreased to 0.42%, this due to a decrease in the prices of Pharmaceutical products by 5.26%.

Transport

Inflation rate of Transport group increased by 5.95%, due to an increase in the prices of Fuels and lubricants for personal transport equipment by 14.87% after the announcement of the Ministry of Energy regarding deregulation of fuel prices in the UAE since August 2015. In addition to that, prices of other services in respect of personal transport equipment increased by 8.00% and prices of Spare parts and accessories for personal transport equipment increased by 3.15%.

Communication

Communication group prices decreased to record 0.35% due to the decrease in the prices of Telephone and Telefax Equipment by 10.06%.

Recreation and Culture

Inflation rate of Recreation and Culture group decreased by 6.49% due to a decrease in the prices of Holidays' Packages by 11.62%, followed by the prices of Recording Media by 7.64% and a decrease by 6.45% in the prices of Equipment for the Reception, Recording and Reproduction of Sound and Pictures.

Education

Inflation rate of Education group has increased by 5.57%, as a result of an increase in the fees of Post-Secondary non-Tertiary Education by 9.48%, followed by Pre-Primary and Primary education fees by 5.96% and Secondary Education fees by 5.69%.

It is worth to mention that the Consumer price index (CPI) - Education Group inflation measures the changes in tuition fees of schools and Post-secondary non-tertiary level, and it is different from cost of education index (ECI). Where (ECI) measures the operating expenses for schools.

Restaurants and Hotels

Inflation rate of Restaurants and Hotels group reached 2.11%, due to an increase in the prices of Restaurants and Cafés by 2.38% and prices of Canteens by 1.46%.

Miscellaneous Goods and Services

Inflation rate of Miscellaneous Goods and Services group increased by 12.33%. As the prices of Transport Insurance increased by 60.70% after the issuance of the new unified regulation for vehicle insurance policies since January 2017, followed by an increase in Rehabilitation Centers prices by 5.19%. Additionally, the prices of other Financial Services increased by 0.37%.
