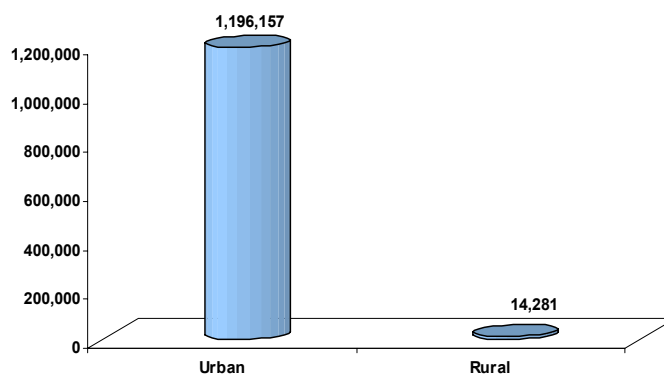


## Social Characteristics of the Population 2005

### Population (10 years and over) by location (urban/rural)

According to 2005 census , the total number of population (10 years and over) in Dubai Emirate has reached (1,210,438) individuals such represents (91.60%) of total population in Emirate of Dubai (1,196,157) out of them (98.82%) live in urban places and (14,281) live in rural areas such represents (1.18%) live in rural areas.

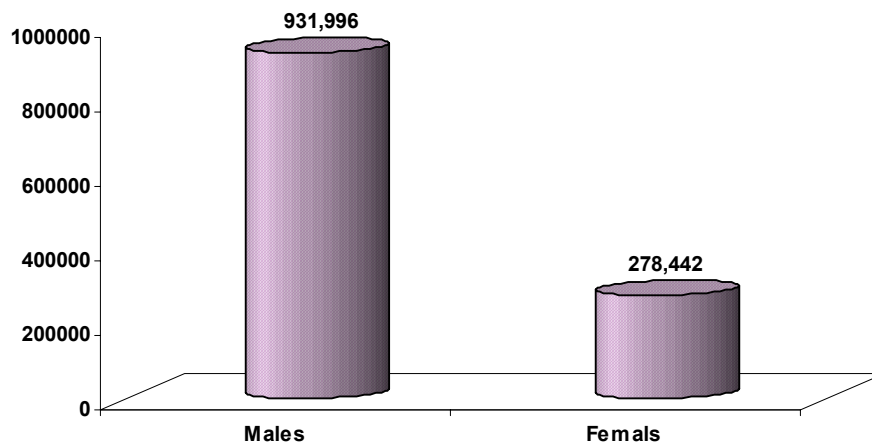
**Population (10 years and over) by Location -Emirate of Dubai

### Population (10 years and over) by Sex (males/females)

On 2005 , The total Male population of Dubai (10 years and over) has reached (931,996) individuals represents (77%) and (278,442) are females represents ( 23%).

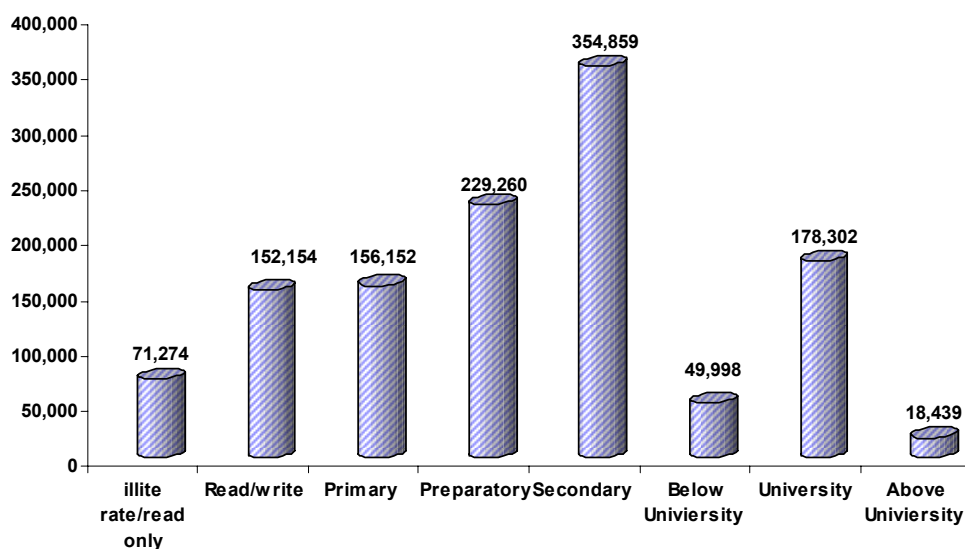
**Population ( 10 years and over ) by Sex - Emirate of Dubai 2005**



### Population (10 years and over ) by educational status:

Analyzing the population based on educational status (10 years and over) it was noted that population in secondary school category reached (354,859) that represents (29.32%) total of the population within this category the percentage of males (74.73%) is more than that of females percentage (25.27%) yet the number of population have illiteracy (10 years and over ) reached (71,274) that represent (5.89%) the majority of them (85.77%) are males . This due to the high percent of males of Dubai society that resulted of high male ratio of non-local labour.

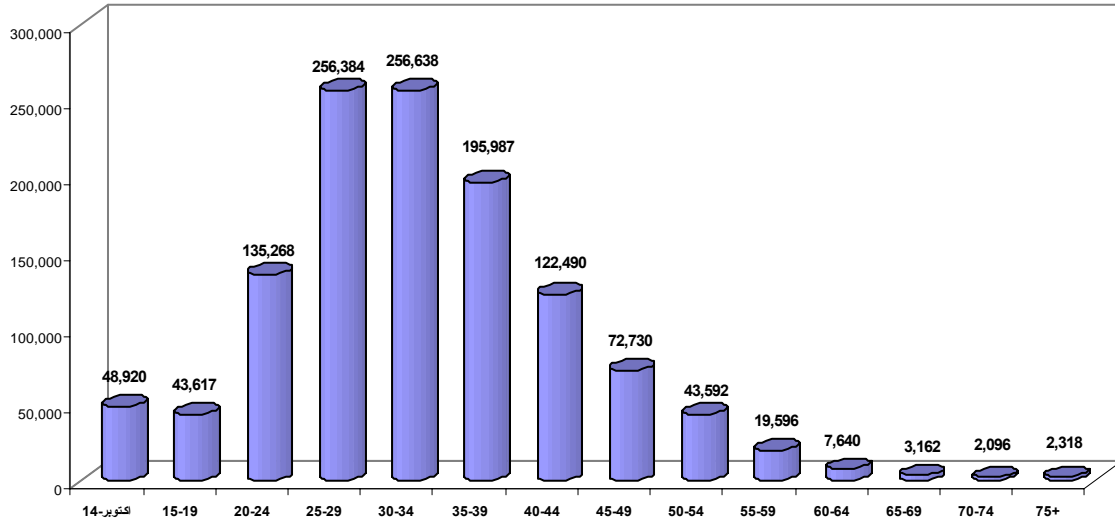
### Population ( 10 years and over ) by Educational Status - Emirate of Dubai 2005



### Population (10 years and over) by age

Analyzing the population in Dubai (10 years and over ), it was noted that more than one fifth (21.20%) of the total population (10 year and over) fall in the age group (30-34) and percentage of males is (81.25%) and females percentage (18.75% ). Followed directly with the age group (25-29) which represents ( 21.18%) of total population (10 year and over) and the percentage of males (81.71%) while for females (18.29%). The age group (35-39) came in the third rank as it represents (16.19%) of the total population (10 year and over) out of them (80.15%) males and (19.85% females). Such means that those three age groups (25-29), ( 30-34), (35-39), represent (58.57%) of total population (10 years and over) Emirate of Dubai

### Population (15 years and over) by marital status

- The number of married population in Emirate of Dubai reached (820,385), represents that (70.63%) of the total population (15 years and over) the percentage of males (80.27%) outnumbered the females (19.73%). Besides, (27.65%) of the total population within the group remained unmarried (321,093) the ratio of males (73.91%) outnumbered the females (26.09%).
- The increase of males more than females in that group (15 years and over) is due to the increase of male labour expatriates remarkably over than females that could be regarded by some active economic sectors such as (construction trade,... etc) in Dubai Emirate.
- The number of divorced males and females reached (5,592) represents (0.48%) while the number of widowed reached (14,448) males and females which represents (1.24%)
